The Engineers' Club of St. Louis, in cooperation with the Engineering Foundation of St. Louis, announces the following scholarships for students who are pursuing a degree in an accredited engineering program and who reside in the Missouri counties of St. Louis, St. Charles, Franklin or Jefferson, or the Illinois Counties of St. Clair, Madison or Monroe. Applicants must have a current Club member sponsor to be accepted.

The 2021 Jake Jare Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a high school senior pursuing an engineering education. This scholarship is for \$2,500, for each of up to four years, provided the individual meets the scholarship renewal requirements.

The 2021 Engineers' Club Member Recognition Scholarship is awarded to a high school senior or any undergraduate pursuing an engineering education. This is a one-time \$2,500 scholarship.

The 2021 Young Engineers Committee Scholarships are awarded to two high school seniors or any undergraduates pursuing an engineering education. These are one-time \$2,500 scholarships.

The 2021 Leonard Kirberg Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a high school senior or any undergraduate pursuing an engineering education. This a one-time \$2,500 scholarship.
